INDOOR CROQUET

8 to 12 can play



Quintessentially English: seemingly genteel, but in fact very competitive and engaging, building lots of team spirit, and encouraging consensus and tactical awareness; for authenticity the game is played with outdoor Jaques balls, mallets and hoops.

Golf Croquet: the most interactive and social form of the game which we've adapted into a fun and engaging team activity for groups; special rules have been added to ensure competitive and yet safe indoor play.

Our approach: we like to get people playing croquet straightaway and we keep things informal – only mentioning rules if they help with play.

2nd generation version: artificial grass 4m x 8m + safety edging = 5m x 9m required, plus space for walkways etc.

Event use: break from meeting or pre/post dinner; works well stand-alone or with other indoor games etc. or as part of a theme.

Numbers: for maximum player throughput, risk assessment and health & safety purposes, two croquet coaches run one game each; two games with 2-a-side = 8 players, and with 3-a-side = 12 players; short games of 15-20 minutes are possible so many more can play.

Doubles: 2-a-side suits couples and individuals; 2 play 2 (or just 1); player's go every 4th turn = the most interactive team size.

Triples: 3-a-side suits people on their own, ideal for groups; 3 play 3 (or 2); if all couples, some get split up; player's go every 6th turn = perfect for most events.

Options: fixed sessions or open play/have-a-go; just for fun or a tournament; for example, a knockout competition for 24 people will involve separate quarter finals for 12 players each, followed by semi-finals and a final, all possible within two hours.

Availability: by prior booking only, i.e. not available as automatic back-up for outdoors.

Set-up requirements: 4 hours minimum set-up time with room broken down from previous use, empty of all unnecessary furniture, and clean and ready for immediate set-up from get-in time; suggested ideal room size 11m x 7m; external/easy access to room preferred with parking close by for loading in and out.
